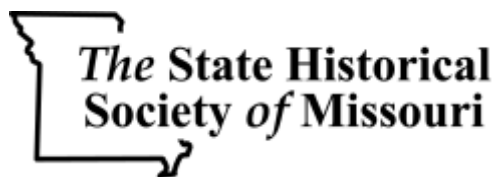

PLANT TODAY, EAT TOMORROW

Guilty! Yes, I am guilty of feeding my kids hot dogs and boxed mac and cheese during those rushed years when we were hustling from soccer, to violin lessons, to swimming. Easy, attractive meals that I realized years later, were not providing my kids with essential nutrients. The diet changed during their high school years. I introduced whole grains (brown rice replacing white rice), more veggies, leafy greens. The transition was necessary, but it was not peaceful. In the end, I prevailed! Today my adult kids all make it a priority to consume healthy foods - a couple of them even turned pescatarian. They learned that

food is what fuels your body and brain. Thankfully, current new parents are much more informed and make better choices for their kids. However, healthy food can be expensive. Good quality fruit and vegetables can only come from soil rich with nutrients that will be passed on to the plants we eat; and it can be pricey and out of



Fast forward to 2013 when I was thrilled to discover a terrific organization, right here in Columbia, that was growing fruit and vegetables and donating to the local food pantries. The Columbia Center for Urban Agriculture (CCUA), founded in 2009 by a visionary team who believed we could grow top quality produce within our city to increase accessibility of healthy food. CCUA's Urban Farm on Smith street is also a center of education for our elementary schools. In addition, their Opportunity Gardens Program provides the tools and know-how to low income Columbia residents so they can grow wholesome food in their own backyard.

And guess what? CCUA is partnering with Columbia Farmers Market and the city to build an Agriculture Park ! The park will expand CCUA's reach and improve its educational facilities, including an industrial teaching kitchen. The project on Clary-Shy Park, the land adjacent to the ARC, is breaking ground this spring thanks to many generous supporters who helped raise the initial funds. Now we need YOU! We need your financial support, AND we need your wisdom and input as we formulate the programming that will take place at the Agriculture Park.

Let's plant a legacy today so that many can eat tomorrow.

DISTINGUISHED PHYSICIAN AWARD - 2017



Joseph and Mary Muscato

On January 20, 2018 during their annual Gala the Boone County Medical Society awarded to Joseph Muscato, MD their Distinguished Physician of the Year Award.

In his nomination letter Dr. Mary Muscato states:

“Joseph Muscato has made a significant contribution to medicine in Boone and surrounding counties as the founder of Missouri Cancer Associates (MCA) in 1982. It was then called Hematology-Oncology Associates of Columbia and he started it as a solo practice. Soon it grew to an 11 physicians group. In addition Radiation Oncology joined MCA with 6 more physicians.

Dr. Muscato is a Fellow of the American College of Physicians (ACP) and has received the following awards: Outstanding Young Internist from the Missouri ACP; The Laureate Award from the Missouri ACP; Best Doctors in America – multiple years

He has been on the Council of the Missouri ACP, locally been in charge of Medical Oncology at Boone Hospital Center, been in charge of the Cancer Committee, Tumor Board and is currently the Medical Director at Boone Hospital Center of the Stewart Cancer Center. He was instrumental in starting the official state affiliate of the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) in the 1990s—originally it was called the Missouri Society of Clinical Oncology but is currently called the Missouri Oncology Society of which he

was President for many years and continues on their Board of Directors. As part of this he also served on the Clinical Practice Committee of ASCO and was on the Carrier Advisory Committee for J5 contractor for Medicare.

He has been teaching medical students physical diagnosis and how to care for patients for many years. He has been the lead researcher at MCA for CALGB, US Oncology research and has given numerous talks about various types of cancer for years.

Dr. Muscato has been in practice for 36 years, the first year being on the faculty at the University of Missouri, Division of Hematology/Oncology then he started up Missouri Cancer Associates in 1982.”

Dr. Muscato has been married to Dr. Mary Slotsky Muscato for 45 years and they have three sons, Jeffrey, Andrew and David.

Dr. Muscato's education: AB, Political Science, magna cum laude with honors, from the University of Pennsylvania; MD from the University of Pennsylvania; Residency, Internal Medicine from University of Missouri, Columbia (Medical Resident of the Year for all three years) and he did his Fellowship, Hematology and Medical Oncology at Duke University Medical Center.

He holds memberships in: American College of Physicians, American Society of Clinical Oncology, Missouri State Medical Association, Boone County Medical Society, Missouri Society of Clinical Oncology (past President) and Missouri Oncology Society (past President).

He holds certifications with the National Board of Medical Examiners, American Board of Internal Medicine, American Board of Internal Medicine (subspecialty of Hematology) and the American Board of Internal Medicine (Subspecialty of Medical Oncology).

He has written or co-written 15 articles and 12 abstracts.
